**Holiday Club Meeting** – today at 11.30am in the Meeting Room.

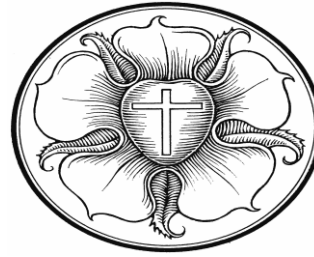
